



Maid: cleans the residence, does laundry including ironing, serves the members of household

Cook: does grocery shopping and prepares the meals in the household

Yaya: takes care of the children of the household

All rounder: performs a combination of the above, including, cleaning, laundry, grocery shopping, cooking, and in some cases, child care




