
To centralize current information regarding Southeast Asian Studies and faculty at Rutgers University.

To address the hypocrisy of "Beloved Community," as shown through the lack of academic resources provided to Southeast Asian students.

"Rutgers fails to adhere to its own ideals of inclusivity and limits its own academic research by undervaluing Southeast Asian studies in the greater context of Asian and Asian American studies. As a result, Southeast Asian students are unable to feel wholly accepted and appreciated at an institution that does not reflect their own culture academically."

### 689M People in SEA

Over 689 million people live in the 11 countries recognized as Southeast Asia.

## **22M Asian Americans**

Over 22 million Asian-identified people currently live in the United States of America. This statistic is not exclusive to Southeast Asians. This is the fastest-growing demographic in the nation.

## 29% of this is SEA\*

In 2019, 29% of the Asian population in the United States were identified as Vietnamese or Filipino. Other Southeast Asian groups were listed under "Other," which added to 15% of the total Asian population.



"Obliviousness about white advantage, like obliviousness about male advantage, is kept strongly inculturated in the United States so as to maintain the myth of meritocracy, the myth that democratic choice is equally available to all" (McIntosh, 1989, p.5).

"Although an impressive number of Americans whose ancestors are from Cambodia, Laos, and Vietnam ('Southeast Asian Americans') have achieved tremendous success in education, a disproportionate number have found it difficult to succeed academically. Yet their difficulties are largely invisible to policymakers, who end to look only to the aggregate data on Asian Americans—data that suggest that, as one large undifferentiated group, Asian Americans are doing quite well" (Yang, 2004, p.1)

The Southeast Asian diaspora is largely made up of refugees or descendants or refugees. Many of these refugees are women and children, yet do not receive specific care based on these identities, making the state of Southeast Asians a feminist issue.

Almost half of the migrants of Southeast Asian origin — 11.7 million — are women. However, in some countries, the percentage is much higher; in Thailand, for example, it is 61 per cent, and more than 55 per cent in Malaysia and the Lao People's Democratic Republic (UN DESA, 2020).

Along with gathering information. I wrote a short piece advocating for more Rutgers resources dedicated to Southeast Asian Studies.


## Gather Nov. 2023


#### Design Nov.-Dec. 2023


With the External Social Chair of SEARU, Sophia Delrosario, I designed the Instagram graphics and website visuals of the information we would be publishing.


